



Stop the Threat: Nuclear Iran

What are the threats posed by a nuclear Iran?

- **A nuclear Iran would pose an existential threat to Israel.** As the leading state sponsor of terrorist groups such as Hamas and Hezbollah, a nuclear-armed Iran would endanger the State of Israel. Furthermore, a nuclear Iran would endanger US soldiers in the region.
- **A nuclear Iran would destabilize the Middle East.** Iran's acquisition of nuclear weapons would likely touch off a regional nuclear arms race.
- **Nuclear weapons would embolden Ahmadinejad's regime.** The repression of Iranian protestors after the disputed presidential elections shows the true nature of the Iranian regime: a brutal theocratic dictatorship. Possessing nuclear weapons would embolden this regime, allowing it to extend its influence throughout the region.

How Can I Take Action?

- Thank your Senator for supporting the **Comprehensive Iran Sanctions, Accountability and Divestment Act**. This legislation imposes sanctions on companies providing refined petroleum to Iran or helping Iran expand its own refining capacity. Stronger sanctions against Iran would force Tehran to confront a real choice: continue its illicit nuclear program and risk economic ruin or suspend the program.
