MISSION STATEMENT

“The mission of Temple Emunah is to perpetuate Judaism by maintaining an egalitarian, Conservative community, linked to God and *Klal Yisrael* through religious, educational, cultural and social activities in order to instill in its members a common bond of *mitzvot* (ethical values and actions).”

Privileges of membership shall include the right to participate in all Temple activities and attend services throughout the year; the right to seats at High Holy Day services upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall determine; the right to vote at all membership meetings; the right to send children to the schools of the Temple upon such terms and conditions as the Board may provide; and such other rights and privileges as the Board may make available.
