

# Join the Women's Seder Committee

Every few years, Temple Emunah hosts a Women's Seder, a chance for the women of our community to gather before Passover to celebrate women's roles in Jewish history. We learn, we sing, we dance, we share, we eat in the spirit of *Pesah*. The event is open to all women.

But long before the event is held, the learning begins. Each seder features a *new* haggadah, created specifically for the event. Join us as we form the women's seder committee and begin to design and compose our next haggadah. We'll brainstorm themes (previous themes have been women activists, women from around the world, women of the Torah), write new segments, choose photos and artwork, and design the layout. We welcome both creative folks (writers and artists), musical folks (music selection is important), and curious folks (women who are interested in learning more about women's roles in history and in Judaism). After the haggadah is done, we design and plan the seder itself.

**Our first meeting will be at 10:30 AM on Sunday, October 5 at Temple Emunah.** We meet monthly, either at the synagogue or in one of our homes, as we produce our new haggadah. We hope you can come to our first meeting, but if you can't, you are welcome to join us at *any* point.
