

A Mutually Neurotic Relationship: Israel and the Vatican



On **Saturday, December 26**, Professor Raymond Cohen will give a short talk during Shabbat services entitled: **The Jewish Document--fifty years after**. After kiddush he will talk about the relationship between Israel and the Vatican.



Raymond Cohen was born in Edinburgh, Scotland and moved to Israel in 1968. He is Professor Emeritus of International Relations at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem: During his career he also taught at Brown, Chicago, and Georgetown Universities and was a peace fellow twice at the U.S. Institute of Peace. From 2008-2010 he was Corcoran Professor of Christian-Jewish Understanding at Boston College. His books include Theater of Power, Dialogue of the Deaf, and Saving the Holy Sepulchre.
