## IN HONOR



**Lowell Bensky** was born in Rochester NY in 1926 and raised in Orange NJ. He belonged to a Conservative shul, led by Rabbi Landau, an ordained Lithuanian rabbi who was one of the first graduates of JTS. The rabbi encouraged Lowell and other bar mitzvah boys to hold their own separate Shabbat services. Before long, they found a recent immigrant from Hungary, Mr. Boss, who taught them how to read Torah, and Lowell never stopped.

Lowell has been a member of Temple Emunah for 50 years. He and his wife Janet (z"l) joined in September 1965. By 1968 Lowell was chair of the Religious Committee. When Rabbi Joel Meyers heard Lowell chant, he was so impressed with the beauty of his reading that he enlisted him to teach others.

Lowell has taught more than 175 students, of all ages, to *leyn Torah* or to chant *Haftarat*. Among them are Jill Wollins and Susan Lipson, who currently teach our b'nei mitzvah students, David Ezekiel, Doug Wissoker, many of the students in the Adult B'nei Mitzvah classes, Rabbi Meyers' daughter Renana, who still chants Torah in Israel, and Rabbi Annie Tucker [daughter of Marsha Tucker and Ken Tucker (z"l)].

In deep appreciation, Temple Emunah dedicates our *Sefer Haftarat* to Lowell Bensky for his unfailing service to our congregation and his influence in perpetuating the religious education of our youth.

## IN MEMORY



**Debby Brosgol** (z"l) and her husband Ben joined Temple Emunah over 35 years ago. Their children, Abigail and Dan, had their B'nei Mitzvah here.

Debby attended Hebrew College and received a Masters in Jewish Studies. She was a tutor for many years at Temple Beth El and Temple Shir Tikvah as well as in private practice, teaching Hebrew and preparing students for their Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

At Temple Emunah, Debby was in charge of the library for many years, managed the Judaica Shop, and was a frequent floor *gabbai*. Debby wrote a monthly book review for the Bulletin, read Torah regularly, enjoyed chanting the blessing for the New Moon, assigned *Haftarah* portions throughout the year, led Monday evening *minyán*, participated in *Perek Yomi*, and was a member of the Religious Committee. She was active in Sisterhood and was a Light of Torah, and for many years she was the Sisterhood's Torah Fund Chair.

Temple Emunah lovingly remembers Debby Brosgol, a temple "Renaissance Woman" with many talents, a strong volunteer spirit, and a deep commitment to Judaism.

## MEET THE SCRIBE



**Rabbi Yochanan Salazar-Loewe** is a master *sofer* (scribe), educator, and lecturer.

Born in Ecuador, South America, he moved to the US as a teen. Before becoming a scribe, he studied in Hudson College and later attended NJIT where he majored in electronics engineering and public speaking. While in college he met his wife Hanna; together they moved to Florida where they live with their six children.

He received his rabbinic ordination in 2004 from Rabbi Daniel Channen in Beit Shemesh, Israel. In Miami, Rabbi Salazar studied the art of *Sofrut* as an apprentice under both Rabbis Druin at Sofer on Site. After years of training he received his ordination as a *Sofer* from Rabbi Eliyahu Ben Hayyim, the Head of Shepardi studies at Yeshiva University in New York. He now heads the Torah Restoration Department of Sofer On Site.
