### ***THE SIX DAY WAR FIFTY YEARS LATER: WHERE TO FROM HERE?***

Fifty years after the Six Day War, Israel is struggling to determine its future in relation to its Palestinian neighbors, its vision for peace, its relationship to the land, and what values will guide these decisions. Join us as we discuss our reactions to the different points of view within Israel. We encourage you to prepare by reading essays that describe different approaches to peace and relations with the Palestinians, and a handout that helps us understand typical patterns in dealing with conflict. The format for this conversation will be different from the one we have used previously. However, the purpose is the same—providing a respectful forum that enables us to deepen our understanding of the values and concerns that shape our different views. We plan to discuss the positive changes that resulted from the Six Day War and the impact that 50 years of occupation has had on Israel and the divisions within Israel over the occupation. And as we look towards Yom Ha'zikaron and Yom Ha'atzmaut, we will discuss what feels most important for us to focus on as we mark these milestones. We hope to have a variety of perspectives represented.
